

HB Land, Hill Barton: Hedge Survey Schedule

Unless otherwise stated all hedges are C category specimens and are predominantly comprised of elm approx 11-14m high with canopy radius of 3m and DBH of 175-200mm. Unless otherwise indicated any hedge would be suitable for retention following remedial management work as specified. Retained hedges should be coppiced and 40-45% of the elm killed off then supplemented with new native species planting. The 2019 survey is based on the original survey of the whole of the Hill Barton development area but each schedule only includes hedges that are within or adjacent to the site boundaries.
